# Youth Led and Youth Serving Organizations (YLOs/YSOs) INPUTS AND COMMENTS

## Introduction

This memorandum is submitted following a Public Notice dated 26th November 2024 by the Ministry of Youth Affairs, Creative Economy, and Sports in the matter of the review of the Youth Bill, 2024. This review is aimed at addressing gaps, ensuring inclusivity, and improving the effectiveness of the Bill in promoting youth empowerment and development.

In a virtual forum led by YLOs/YSOs on the 17<sup>th</sup> December 2024 coordinated through the HENNET youth representatives from across the country presented their reviews of the proposed Youth Bill 2024 highlighting key recommendations and amendments as below.
